

Highlights of the Mass Fatality Management (MFM) Survey conducted by NHA 2008

27 responses were received from the 58 hospitals in Nevada

2/3 reported that they did not have a dedicated morgue

Only 2 of those who did report having refrigeration

Only 1 identified having expanded refrigeration storage

37% reported that they had body bags available

48% reported that they had toe tags available

30% reported that their facility has a MFM annex to their emergency operation plan (EOP)

67% reported that their MFM's are NOT integrated into local jurisdiction plans.

30% of the reporting hospitals said that they do have MOUs in place to help address MCI's

Only 3 hospitals reported having fingerprinting capabilities
